

Brilliant performance by GVPIHC&IT students in 4th Colloquium - AIIMS Mangalagiri

A team of 10 first year medical students represented our college at the 4th Cerebration-Colloquium event held at AIIMS Mangalagiri this year. Knock-out rounds were held in each of the three first year subjects as prelims, semifinals and finals respectively, and our college got selected for all 3 rounds based on performance in each preceding round. The seminar team comprising of Akhila for the anatomy round, Varsha for the physiology round and Vennela for the biochemistry round did really well, and answered most of the questions posed by both subject experts and audience members. Moreover, our college scored the second highest points in each seminar round, thus bagging individual silver medals for Physiology seminar. Manaas saxena and Janhvi chaumwal, who were part of the charts and models event as main team members, also did very well and their points also added up to the seminar points which helped us declare our college as the second runner up in the event, over 15 other participating colleges from AP, Telangana, Tamilnadu and Karnataka. Manaas saxena along with Samruddhi patil won First prize for their Physiology model. Apart from the main team of 5 members, Nagendra, Tejus Geethika and Shravani also participated as delegates and were appreciated for their models and charts. Shravani even bagged the delegate silver medal for her Anatomy chart. The team and delegates were chosen by respective HoD's and professors. All the faculty members of preclinical departments encouraged the participants and oversaw all presentations multiple times. Jayabalakrishna Assistant Professor from physiology department accompanied the team to Mangalagiri. Dean and Director also encouraged the team and heartily congratulated them upon winning.
