We were very much surprised and dismayed to receive your letter of rejection for LoP alongwith decision to debar admissions for two years namely 2017-18 and 2018-19 and decision to encash bank guarantee of Rs.2.00 crores even after fulfilling and complying with the deficiencies mentioned in the conditional approval by Government of India.

The GVP Institute of Health Care and Medical Technology has fulfilled all the deficiencies mentioned in the conditional approval by Government of India which is conveyed in the letter submitted to Under-Secretary, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GoI on dt. 4.2.2017 and also submitted at the time of personal hearing on 8.2.2017 to the Hearing Committee.

- 1. The MCI Assessors have not said anything about non-compliance of the points raised in 11.3.2016 inspection in the compliance inspection on 28 and 29th December, 2016 and raised fresh objections which also have been fulfilled and submitted to the hearing committee.
- 2. When the case is presented before the hearing committee constituted by you, it is clearly mentioned by them that the previous conditions are fulfilled and new conditions are only to be verified. It seems that DGHS recommended our college for your consideration as per news paper report.
- 3. OC also recommended the college for confirmation of LoP as per news paper report.

The students are admitted for 2016-17 and faculty is recruited for 2017-18 for 2nd MBBS and also all the para-clinical departments and laboratories are made ready as per the norms of MCI for the first renewal. We are updating our website as per MCI norms and the data is available in the website.

At this stage the rejection of LoP and ban of admissions for two years will badly effects the Institution and the staff particularly teaching staff will lose confidence in their career opportunities which will effect standards of the Institute.

Hence I request your goodselves to reconsider your decision of denying LoP and ban on admissions for 2017-18 and 2018-19 and encashment of bank guarantee.

Deficiencies mentioned in the inspection report on 11.3.2016 and mentioned in conditional approval for compliance

- 1. Shortage of Residents is 28.26% as detailed in the report.
- 2. Some Senior Residents are staying in the campus except on emergency day.
- 3. Bed Occupancy is 56.49% on day of assessment.
- 4. Wards: Male Medicine ward, Skin & VD, Tb & Chest, Psychiatry, Pediatrics, O.G., Male & Female General Surgery, Orthopedics, Ophthalmology, ENT wards are not as per MSR Regulations like there is no Examination cum Treatment room, Pantry, Store Room, Demonstration, Duty room.
- 5. Most of the patients admitted in General Medicine wards did not require admission. They had minor vague complaints like bodyache, weakness, etc.
- 6. Casualty: Central O₂ and Central Suction are not available. Pipeline was shown to assessors but it was not functional. Emergency Drug Tray is not available. Portable X-ray machine is not available. Patients admitted in Casualty had minor non-specific complaints like headache, weakness, etc.
- 7. ICUs: NICU is practically non-functional. There was only 1 patient in PICU.
- 8. O.T.: Septic O.T. is no functional.
- 9. Speech Therapy room is too small.
- 10. Nursing Staff: GNM Nursing students doing their intership are shown as Staff Nurses. Resultanty, deficiency of inadequate number of Staff Nurse remains.
- 11. Nursing Hostel: In 1 room, 5-7 nurses are staying which is not as per Regulations.
- 12. There was NIL Normal Delivery & NIL Caesarean Section on day of assessment.
- 13. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report

Deficiencies mentioned in the compliance inspection on 28th and 29th December, 2016

- 1. ICUs: There was only 1 patient in NICU/PICU on day of assessment. NICU/PICU does not have Central O₂ and Central Suction.
- 2. Casualty: Separate Casualty for O.G. is not available. Minor not available.
- 3. ABG Analyzer is not available.
- 4. Anatomy department: Only 1 articulated set is available. Only 4 cadavers are available.
- Physiology department: Clinical Physiology laboratory is not adequate.
- 6. In Demonstration room, Audiovisual aids cannot be placed for proper focus and no roof mounted equipment is available.
- 7. Central Photography Section is not functional.
- 8. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the report.
